

## Picture A Cure Instructions

- Work with your staff contact to order a Picture A Cure Relay Advocacy kit.
  - Prior to your event, familiarize yourself with the contents of the kit:
    - Picture A Cure forms (50)
    - Pens
    - Lapel stickers (50)
    - Relay Advocacy Chair apron
    - Banner (1)
  - At the event, take the Picture A Cure forms around to campsites and ask people to insert their personal story about how cancer has impacted their life. Be sure that they include their contact information at the bottom of the form. Inform them about how their story will be used to urge lawmakers to support our effort to save lives by making cancer a top national priority.
  - After the event is over, collect all the Picture A Cure forms and work with your staff partner to make copies to send to the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network office (ACS CAN, 901 E Street, NW, Suite 500, Washington, DC, 20004).
  - Take the originals and work with your committee and staff partner to personalize a cover of a notebook with something that represents your local Relay For Life. Finally, put the forms in the binder so that they can be delivered to your Member of Congress at a recess meeting in the district office. Be creative! Feel free to add scrapbook pages with pictures of your Relay event.
  - Work with your staff partner to find the appropriate time to meet with your US representative or senator to deliver your Picture A Cure scrapbook.
- \* If your Relay event has selected the electronic Picture A Cure activity, training will be provided to you and your staff partner prior to your event.
