Roles & Responsibilities

As the ACT! Lead, you will have the opportunity to:

- Serve as a key volunteer contact with your member of Congress and State elected officials
- Serve as the principal contact for other Team members and manage Team activities, working closely with your state staff partners
- Coordinate with State Lead Ambassador and staff to plan and implement federal and state level legislative activities
- Help develop and implement an action plan for ACS CAN fundraising and member recruitment
- Recruit additional Legislative Ambassadors and advocates to participate in the team's activities and take additional leadership roles as needed
- Implement and participate in state level legislative activities such as state Lobby Days
- Attend required training(s) and assist with training other volunteers as needed
- Establish procedures for maintaining regular contact and meeting with both staff partners and ACT! Team members

Working Together
